## TIPS FOR THE READER

In this kit, you will find a wonderful children’s book and practical resources you can use to help a child develop important lifelong skills. Use these tips to engage the child in talking about the story, further developing vocabulary, comprehension and a love of reading. Finally, use the provided materials and **Activity Instructions** to extend and practice new skills.

### LET’S GO! / VAMOS A SALIR

**Themes covered:** getting ready, routines

**Skills developed:** English and Spanish vocabulary, colors, fine motor skills, print awareness

#### Verbal Prompts

Before reading, ask...

- \* What do you do before you go outside? What do you wear?
- \* What do you put on your feet? Who can say “shoes” in Spanish?

While reading...

- \* Talk about the photographs. Ask: What do you see in this picture? What is the baby doing?
- \* What is on the baby’s head? How do we say hat in Spanish?

After reading, ask...

- \* What’s your favorite place to go? What do you do there? What do you see there? How do you get there?

### Follow These Steps

1. Find and learn the tune from the song “If you’re happy and you know it” on YouTube: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=jzea8D7-EvU>
2. Substitute the lyrics of the song with the lyrics for “The Color Song” and sing along, acting out each of the movements, such as, “put your finger on your head.”

# DRESSING BOARD

*Let's Go! / ¡Vamos a Salir!* or other transportation books

### Supplies You'll Need


- 20" x 20" foam board
- Scissors
- Craft Glue
- Marker
- Large embroidery needle and strong thread
- Vinyl
- Large buttons, zippers, snaps, and hooks and eyes
- Velcro
- Half-inch wide flat athletic shoelaces
- 1 inch grommets
- Large plastic bag(s) or other container

### Kit Assembly Instructions

1. Cut vinyl into 12 pieces, 3x6 inches each. You'll need 12 pieces for each dressing board you create.
2. On one piece of vinyl, sew two buttons near the edge. On another piece of vinyl, cut two button hole/slits on the opposite edge. Make sure the buttons will fit easily into the holes. Glue the two pieces of vinyl on the foam board. Write the word, "buttons" above the buttoning task.
3. Repeat step two with snaps, hook and eye, and Velcro.
4. For the lacing and tying practice, make holes on edges of vinyl 1 inch from the edge and one inch apart. Insert grommet. String a shoelace through the bottom two holes then glue the vinyl to the foam board.
5. Include the book and **Tips for the Reader** in the kit.

# DRESSING BOARD

- Large plastic bag(s) or other container


### Kit Assembly Instructions

3. Include the book and **Tips for the Reader** in the kit.







# TRANSPORTATION PUZZLES (AGES 0-2)

*Let's Go! / ¡Vamos a Salir!* or other transportation books

### Follow These Steps

1. Sit at a table or on the floor. Place all the pieces facing up on the surface. Ask the child to find the two pieces that match.
2. Ask questions about the picture. What is it? Have you ever been on a \_\_\_\_\_? Where did you go?

# TRANSPORTATION LACING GAME (AGES 3-5)

*Let's Go! / ¡Vamos a Salir!* or other transportation books

### Supplies You'll Need


- Car and Plane Images
- Card stock
- Crayons
- Single hole puncher
- Glue stick
- Shoelaces (18 -24 inches long) or yarn
- Masking tape
- Large plastic bag(s) or other container

### Kit Assembly Instructions

1. Print copies of the images on card stock (one copy per child).
2. Punch holes all around the image - 1/2 inch from the edge and 1 inch apart.
3. Tape one end of the shoelace/yarn on the blank side of the lacing card and pull the shoelace through one hole. Alternatively, you could tie a knot in the lace so it can't pull through the hole.
4. Include the book and **Tips for the Reader** in the kit.



# TRANSPORTATION LACING GAME (AGES 3-5)

*Let's Go! / ¡Vamos a Salir!* or other transportation books

### Follow These Steps

1. Provide crayons or markers and a pencil for children to color the picture and trace the word.
2. Then show them how to lace through the holes.
3. Let the child(ren) practice lacing through all the holes.
